Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Minutes of the March 12 Regular Board Meeting were read. Motion made by Penny Bauer to approve the minutes as presented. Mark Weiss seconded the motion. All in favor-3, opposed-0, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

The March 2019 Treasurer's report was presented by Audrey Bauer. The balance on hand as of March 28, 2019 was \$220,161.36.

Payment of Vouchers

Vouchers presented to the Board for payment by Clerk Lisa Ridgeway, totaled \$6,802.73. Motion made by Penny Bauer and seconded by Mark Weiss for Clerk Lisa Ridgeway to pay vouchers. All in favor-3, opposed-0, motion carried.

Chairman Stan Ridgeway said that he will be attending the Durand Rural Fire Department Meeting next Wednesday, and will have an update from the Department for the next Town Board Meeting.

Appointments

Chairman Stan Ridgeway recommended the following appointment and reappointments to the board: Jeff Krisik (Chair), Larry Johnson, Pat Wayne, Paul Simpson, John Wayne, and Trevor Myers (Alternate) for Board of Appeals, and Dave Schneider and Stan Ridgeway for Plan Commission. Mark Weiss made a motion to approve all appointments and reappointments, and Penny Bauer seconded the motion. All in favor-3, opposed-0, motion carried.

ATV/UTV Discussion

Darrell Komro, representing the Pepin County ATV Club and Backcountry ATV Club, distributed maps and said that the ATV Clubs would like access to come to Durand using FF, F, and B. Darrell said that in order to drive an ATV, you must be 16 years old and having been through a classroom safety course. After discussion, Stan Ridgeway made a motion to recommend to Pepin County to open the proposed routes for ATV use. Mark Weiss seconded. All in favor-3, opposed-0, motion carried.

Darrell also asked if the Town of Durand could pass an ordinance to allow Dorwin's Mill Road and Vradenburg Road open for ATV use. Stan said that more legwork would have to be done to draft an ordinance for the township, but he would look into it before the next meeting.
